Modern artists create something new without relying on other artwork and experiment by testing out different ideas.

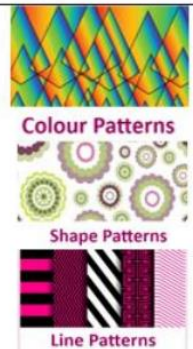

<p>landscape art</p> <p>The depiction of natural scenery using an array of art forms, but mostly painting.</p> 	<p>background</p> <p>The section of a piece of artwork that lies behind other objects (the foreground).</p> <p><i>The background of the painting to the left is the mountains.</i></p>	<p>foreground</p> <p>The elements in a piece of artwork that are closest to you.</p> <p><i>The foreground of the painting to the left is the pink flowers.</i></p>
<p>collage</p> <p>A piece of art made by sticking various <u>different materials</u> onto a backing.</p> 	<p>montage</p> <p>An assembly of images that relate to each other that create a single work of art.</p> 	<p>actual texture</p> <p>The physical feeling from touching a piece of artwork.</p> <p>The physical surface of an artwork.</p>
<p>visual texture</p> <p>An artist can create an illusion so that their work looks like actual textures, but are just tricks of the light on painting or pictures.</p>	<p>mood board</p> <p>An arrangement of images, materials, text etc. that represent a design.
