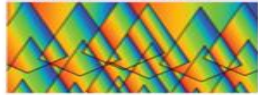

The craft of decorating a fabric using a needle to apply thread into fabric. Embrodiery can incorporate other materials such as beads and sequins.

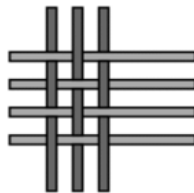

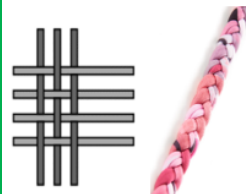
A three-strand plait is formed from crossing over three pieces of fabric multiple times.






